1 Believe- Is there a Truth I need to Believe?

2 Repent- Is there a lie I need to repent of?

- **John 1:12** - But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God

3 Give Thanks- Is there a Truth I can Thank God for?

4 Worship: Is there a Truth about God I can Praise Him for?

5 Petition- Is there a Promise I need?

- **John 15:7** - If you abide in me, and my words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will

be done for you

6 Intercession: Is there someone I can stand in the gap for?

7 Do- Is there an action I can take?
